A member owned Federal Body of 178 Rural Dairy Co-operative Societies spread all over the State of Goa, having 19100 farmer families as their members procuring presently on an average about 65000 liters of milk per day.

A Co-operative Institution, having modern Dairy Plant of 1,10,000 liters per day capacity, supplying 95,000 liters of milk per day to the urban/semi urban consumers through 440 Milk Booths and 850 full time Distribution Agencies.

A modern Cattle Feed Plant, manufacturing around 12,500 M. T. of High Protein, Bypass Cattle Feed, Calf Ration & Pregnancy Ration per annum to cater to the nutritional requirements of milk animals of this State.

Apart from milk Procurement, Processing and Milk Product making like Shrikhand, Amrakhand, Paneer, Lassi, Flavored Milk, Curd & Pure Ghee, the Union is engaged in increasing milk production by providing Technical Input Services, which includes

Veterinary Aid, Vaccination Programme, Artificial Insemination Services for Breeding and Fodder Development Activities. Dairy has also started Productivity Enhancement Programme and Clean Milk Programme for increase in milk production.

Factory Operations Manager gave a presentation related to the history of GOA Dairy Plant. He told students about the white revolution and primitive and newer modes of milk collection and distribution. He also told about the actual milk processing capacity of the plant with the significance of the steps in processing.

The students also came to know about the vision, mission & significant competitive advantage which the company derives from the unique distribution network of bulk vending milk booths, retail outlets and mobile units. The students had over all a good experience with an in-depth learning.

DONA PAULA, GOA ON 29TH SEPTEMBER 2018**



The **National Institute of Oceanography**, founded on 1 January 1966 as one of 37 constituent laboratories of the CSIR, is an autonomous research organization in India to undertake scientific research and studies of special oceanographic features of the Northern Indian Ocean. Headquartered in Goa , Department of BBA 40 students visited on 29th September 2018

The institute is home to about 170 scientists (sanctioned strength is 200) of whom about 120 are Ph.D. holders, about 210 technical and supporting staff, and close to 120 administrative staff. The staff is spread across four campuses. The main campus is at Dona Paula, Goa. About 80% of the staff work here. NIO has three Regional Centres, which are located in Mumbai, Kochi and Visakhapatnam. About 20% of NIO staff is located at these centres.

They explained our students about Patent Rights of NIO, It holds about 50 patents 60% of which has come from marine biotechnology studies. Organisms living in the marine environment carry molecules that could prove beneficial in developing new drugs and other products for healthcare.

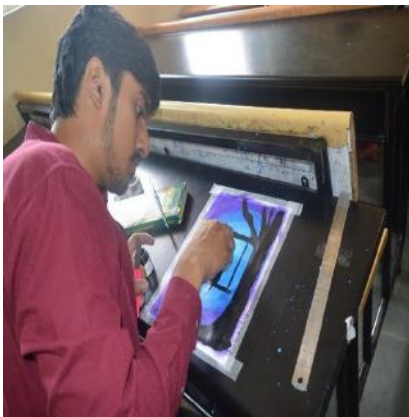

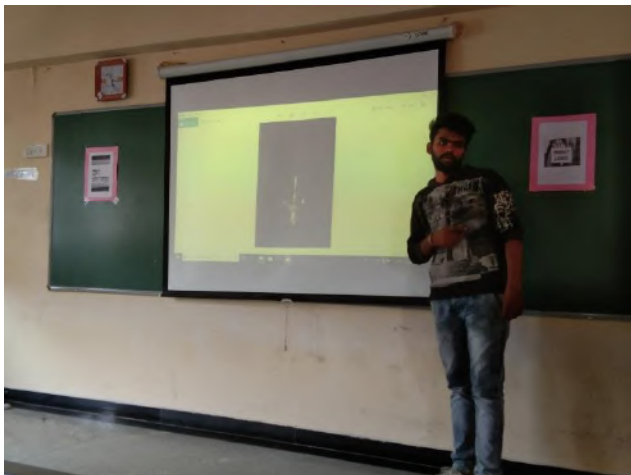
Kalarav 2K19:

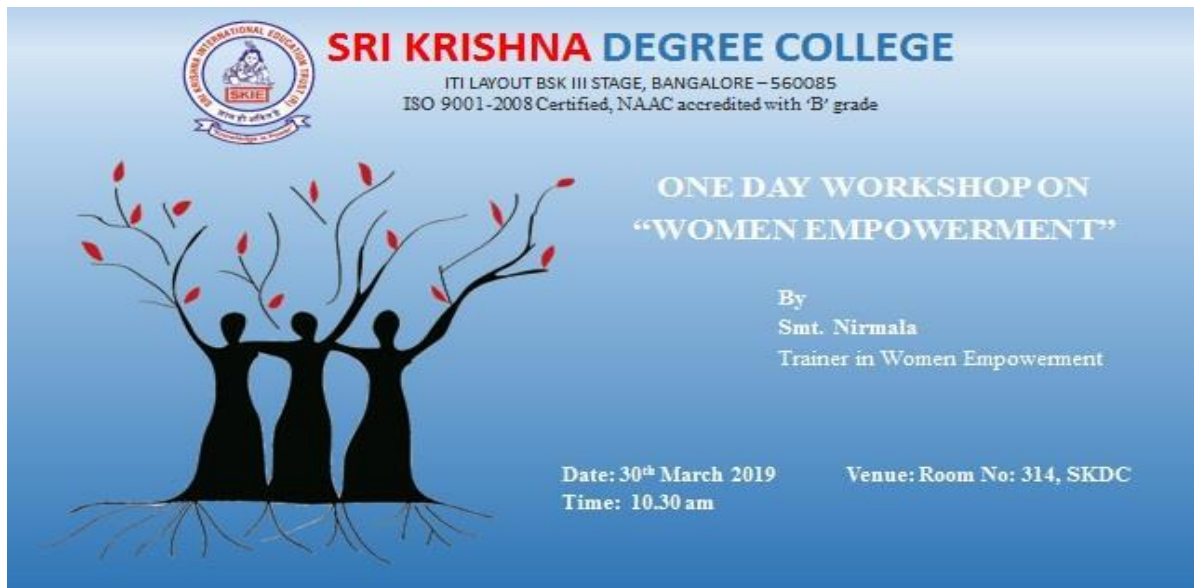

To use Bengaluru City Police Suraksha App during an emergency, press the red button switch to turn green for activating emergency. A one time registration sharing your contacts and your other emergency contact will be required for enabling and coordinating Police Service.

Women in distress can reach the police at the press of a button through the application. The police will track the person with the help of GPS within 9 minutes. Once the person in distress presses the button on the app, SMS along with location details of the person will be sent to the police control room. The team will take immediate action & update the command centre.
