1. EYE DONATION ENROLMENT OF STUDENTS

The students of the institution, Sri Krishna Degree College, Bangalore, were initiated and made to pledge their support towards Eye Donation by Narayana Netralaya, Bangalore.

Objectives of the practice

Eye donation is a noble cause which is practiced in many countries globally to bring about a change in the lives of those people who have lost sight due to various external reasons. The eye donation pledge can be made by any healthy person who is free from any kind of eye diseases and whose eye lens is in a good condition. The donor's eyes will be taken for transplanting in to a recipient's eye only after the death of the individual. When a person dies, his or her eyes are buried or burnt along with the body, and the eyes are wasted. Instead, if the same eyes are donated to a person who has lost sight, it can make the life of the person bright.

Context

Who can receive the eyes

Any person who was earlier having a normal vision but has lost the sight due to injury, trauma, disease or infection, or due to surgery which was not successful and whose nerves of the eyes are perfectly normal, is eligible for an eye transplant.

Enrolment of students for eye- donation at college

The students of our institution, SKDC, were enrolled for donating eyes by pledging their eyes. The enrolment procedure was actively initiated by Dr. Shailaja from Dept of Hindi, and several students and staff were enrolled for the same.

Evidence of success

Number of student enrolments from the college- more than 250 students of our institution have enrolled for eye donation.

Total number of enrolments done by Dr. Shailaja- more than one thousand people have pledged their eyes to the cause.

Dr. Shailaja was felicitated by Narayana Netralaya for her active participation and immense sense of selfless service in the enrolment process and for having got a record number of enrolment for eye-donation from the general public.

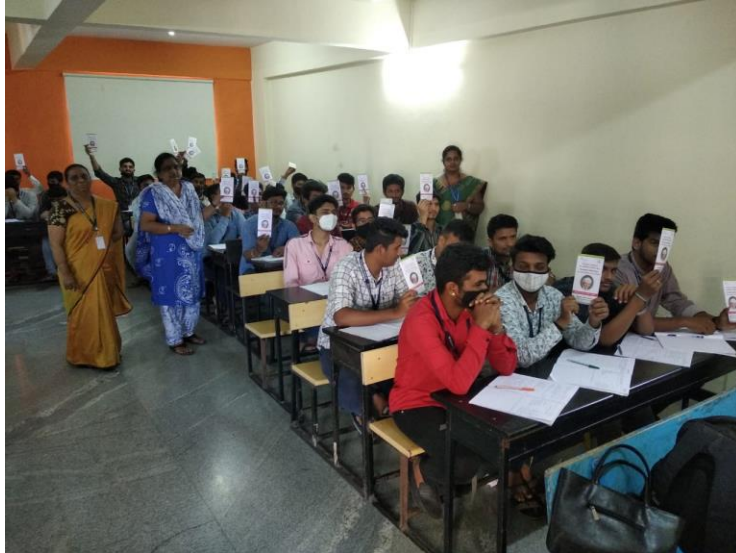
Problems encountered- Dr. Shailaja, being a very dynamic lady, made use of her time during travelling to meet new people and encouraged them to enrol themselves for eye donation. Nevertheless, she did face some problems in form of

- a. Hesitancy among the public to enrol
- b. Some people not wanting to oblige to her request, as she was a stranger to them
- c. Lack of awareness among the public, especially rural people, thus not responding to her request.
- d. Dr. Shailaja attended a seminar on eye donation and discussed the issue of enrolment for eye donation with the Health Minister of Karnataka, Dr. Sudhakar to begin the process of enrolment.
- e. Some of the people whom she met had already pledged their eyes with other eye donor's banks, thus she had to venture newer areas to contact more people.
