Dr. M.R.Doseswami, in his speech said that he had adopted 12 schools.

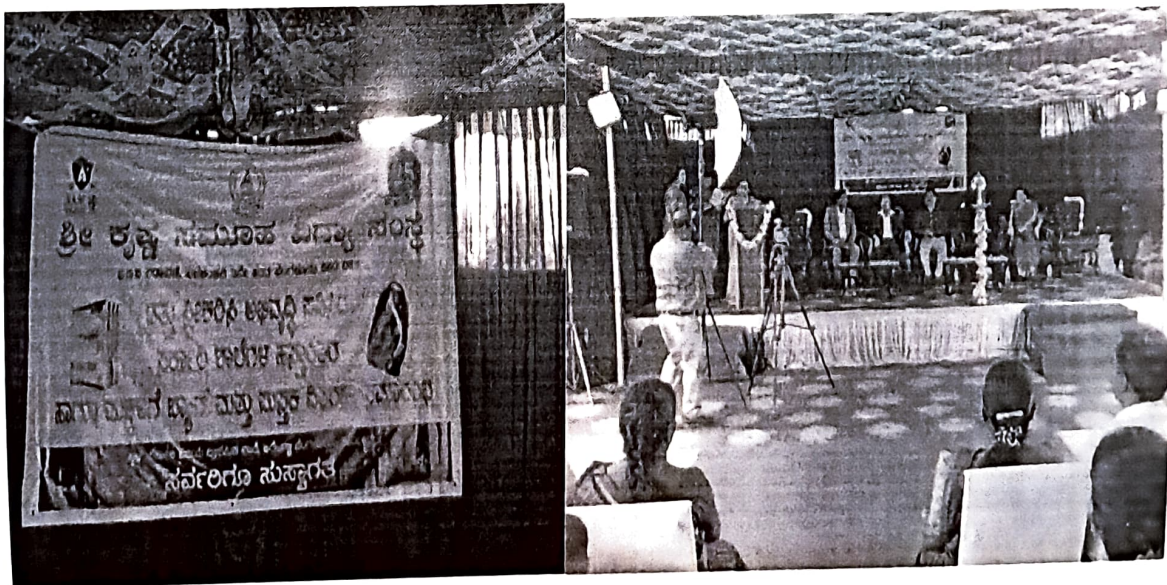
